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New Features in Myridas 9.1

New functionality has been added to:

- Extended Pricing Enhancements
- Catchweights
- Sales Retrospective Discounts
- Advanced Inventory Replenishment

There are also a number of minor changes to other modules.

1. Extended Pricing Enhancements

- New Feature - Order Value Discounts. The Order Value Discount functionality allows Trade Discount in Sales Transaction Entry to be automatically calculated as a percentage of the document total. Customers are assigned to Order Value Discount groups, and each group has its own set of value bands and discount percentages. The discount band is determined from the total value of the order. Individual items can be excluded from the Order Value Discount calculation.
- New Feature - Aggregate Promotions. An order qualifies for an aggregate promotion if the total quantity of a range of items on the order reaches a specified level, or if the order includes a minimum quantity of every item from a list. Multiple quantity breaks can be set against a promotion, with different free items offered as the different break points are achieved.
- Additional functionality – Aggregate Pricing. Aggregate Pricing functionality has been extended to allow aggregate pricing quantity breaks to be based on either the total quantity ordered of the items in an aggregate group or on a count of the number of different items ordered.

2. Catchweights

- Catchweight functionality is now available when operating in a multi-bin inventory environment.

3. Sales Retrospective Discounts

- An item is now allowed to appear on more than one Retrospective Discount plan for the same customer
- A customer may have multiple Retrospective Discount schedules in operation at one time
- An item may be added to more than one Retrospective Discount Group
- A new enquiry shows the details of the transactions making up a Retrospective Discount total

4. Advanced Inventory Replenishment

- A new wizard allows easier setup of items in Inventory Replenishment and loading of historic demand data
- 'Minimum weeks stock' and 'Order up to weeks' are now maintained as numbers of days
- Range maintenance of purchasing unit and number of periods accuracy
- Planning Lead Time update – a new window allows comparison of planning lead time with average lead time, with an option to update the planning lead time
- The demand review window now distinguishes between weekly and monthly demand figures

5. Other Modules

- Call Scheduling – in the Call Processing window, the user can now select the Document Type id before creating a sales document
- Returns Management – when viewing a Return based on Invoice in Sales Transaction Enquiry Zoom, the original Invoice number is shown
- Unit of Measure Management – different default selling units of measure may be set up for an item in different sites
- Inter-Site transfers – a sequential batch or user-id based batch-id can be used when creating inter-site sales orders
